### I. Introduction

On the occasion of the Commemoration of the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Asian-African Conference and the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the New Asian-African Strategic Partnership (NAASP), the Government of Indonesia will host a series of high-level events, under the theme of "Strengthening South-South Cooperation to Promote World Peace and Prosperity", in Jakarta and Bandung from 19-24 April 2015.

Indonesia believes that sixty years after the Bandung Conference in 1955 and a decade since NAASP was launched in 2005, it is timely for countries from both continents to exchange views and share experiences on the robust economic development in their respective regions. The conference is the sole forum in bridging the two regions to foster closer relations, in the spirit of Bandung, the core principles of which are solidarity, friendship and cooperation. It also provides the venue to discuss forward looking solutions to the common emerging challenges faced by Asia and Africa. The Conference also aims to deliver concrete cooperation which would directly benefit and bring prosperity to the people of both regions.

Media representatives must be accredited to cover the Asian and African Summit and its related events.

### II. Accreditation/Registration

#### A. Key Dates for Media Accreditation

7 March 2015	: Online media registration opens
7 April 2015	: Media registration closes, at 12.01 pm Jakarta Time
18 – 19 April 2014	: Issuance of media ID card

#### B. Registration Process:

1. All media representatives who are interested in covering the event must register online at [www.aacc2015.id](http://www.aacc2015.id).
2. Fill in the Media Registration Form and attach soft copies of the following documents:
  - a. Letter of assignment from the editor/executive of the media (file type: PDF)
  - b. A form of identification – KTP for locals or passport for non Indonesian citizens – that is valid for at least six months (file type: PDF)
  - c. A recent digital passport-sized photograph (file type: jpg/png/bmp, with minimum size of 150 kb up to 5 Mb; white background)

3. For successful media accreditation, an e-mail notification will be sent to confirm your accreditation together with a unique ID number.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT INCOMPLETE AND LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.**

### III. Visa Requirement (Foreign Journalists)

Applicants who are not based in Indonesia are required to print and bring along the copy of the confirmation letter to apply for a journalist visa at the nearest Indonesian Embassy/Mission. *The application will be processed in accordance with applicable regulation, please note that confirmation letter does not guarantee issuance of visa.*

### IV. Customs Clearance Requirement

The list of equipments that will be brought by applicants must be legalized by the nearest Indonesian Embassy/Representative office for importation and exportation purposes.

### V. Issuance of Accreditation Pass (ID)

ID pass will be issued at the accreditation center located at Istora Senayan, on 18 – 19 April 2015 at 08.00 am – 05.00 pm for issuance of ID pass.

To be able to collect the ID pass, applicants are required to print and bring along a copy of the confirmation letter with the unique ID number.

ID must be worn and made visible at all times.

### VI. Media Pool

In the event the space availability does not permit, a media pool may be applied. In this regard, special media passes will be issued and must be worn at all times together with ID badges. Others may observe or follow the events at the media center where CCTV may be provided.
